A1C (Glycohemoglobin, HbA1C, Hemoglobin A1C test)

- Blood test for pre-diabetes and diabetes and
- Measures average blood glucose or blood sugar levels over the past 3 months

TSH (Thyroid-Stimulating Hormone)

- Blood test is used to find out how well the thyroid is working and can be performed on men and women

PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen)

- Used primarily to screen for prostate cancer
- The test measures the amount of PSA in the blood

Vitamin D

- Used to determine whether you have enough vitamin D in your body to support normal bodily functions

CMP (Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)

- Frequently ordered panel of 15 tests that gives a healthcare provider important information about the current status of a person's metabolism, including the health of the kidneys and liver, electrolyte and acid/base balance as well as blood glucose and protein levels

CBC (Complete Blood Count)

- Gives an overall view of general health by measuring the health of red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets
