# Lung Cancer Screening: Quick tips for ordering physicians

#### **Medicare Patients**

Lung cancer screenings with low dose computed tomography are covered free of charge (*once each year*) if the the following conditions are met:

- Age **50-77**
- No current signs or symptoms of lung cancer
- current or former smoker who have quit within the last 15 years
- tobacco smoking history of at least 20 "pack years" (an average of one pack (20 cigarettes) per day for 20 years)

Before the first lung cancer screening occurs, Medicare requires that the beneficiary receive an order for a LDCT during a lung cancer screening counseling and shared-decision making visit. Subsequent (annual) screenings only require an order from a physician or qualified non-physician practitioner.
