Job Responsibilities:

- Stock patient room cubbies
- Clear meal service items from patient rooms
- Deliver mail and flowers to patient rooms
- Stock supply closets and rooms
- Check supply expiration dates
- Check wheelchair availability by the elevators
- Disinfect and sanitize all visitor areas such as waiting rooms, vending areas, and computer stations
- Assist nursing staff with cleaning and organizing nurses' stations and desks
- Assist with putting up or taking down seasonal decorations
- Other tasks as assigned
