The Pre-Anesthesia Surgical Services (PASS) department works with surgeons and anesthesia teams to ensure patients are prepared for surgery, including pre-op testing, updated health history and medications, and pre-op instructions. PASS also obtains any outside records and ensures surgery charts are complete prior to surgery. The GI/PASS department's goal is to provide an excellent experience for patients coming to Boone Health for surgery.

Job Responsibilities:

- Staff the front desk
- Greet patients and confirm they have their wrist band
- Direct or escort guests to another area in the hospital
- Answer phones and transfer calls
- Assemble patient packets
- Assemble office mailings
- Clean patient charts
- · Disinfect, sanitize, and organize patient waiting areas
- Other tasks as assigned
- Because providing a high level of customer service to guests and patients is a priority, volunteers in this area need good interpersonal and communications skills.
