Boone Health's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) is a level III intensive care unit for infants where seriously ill newborns can receive the support and treatment they need. The 21-bed NICU is a state-of-the-art facility, with an environment focused on family-centered and developmentally appropriate care. Our nursery staff of maternal-fetal specialists teach parents how to tend to the special needs of premature or ill newborns.

- Buzz visitors into the NICU
- Answer phones and transfer calls to unit nurses
- Stock bedside carts for baby
- Do laundry, including folding and putting away
- Stock supply closets/rooms
- Check supply expiration dates
- Disinfect, sanitize, and organize lactation room
